Temple Sholom is a progressive egalitarian conservative congregation offering a warm and caring environment to enrich the faith of all Jews through spiritual, religious, educational and social activities, each delivering the best of innovative and traditional ideals.

Your connection to the Jewish faith
is a vital part of who you are, and your family.

We encourage full participation by women in synagogue life, as well as offer full access to Jewish worship and religious experience for all of our members. At the same time, we cherish our Jewish traditions, and work to preserve them as a precious legacy for ourselves and our children. Shabbat morning services are more traditional, with an abbreviated Torah reading, a congregant-led rendition of the Haftarah, and either a sermonette or Rabbi's discussion, walking amid the congregants and soliciting comments. Kiddush refreshments follow every services, with ample time to sit, schmooze, and make new friends.

MINYAN provides an intimate and spiritual worship experience. Mornings also include thought-provoking sessions as they relate to Jews in the 21st century led by our Rabbi and/or lay leadership. We welcome all who need to say Kaddish, and we ask each person with a Yahrzeit to talk about their loved one.

HOLIDAY SERVICES and SPECIAL OCCASIONS commemorate Jewish lifecycles throughout the year.

YIZKOR SERVICES are held on Yom Kippur, Shemini Atzeret, the eighth (8th) Day of Passover and the second (2nd) Day of Shavuot. A special free Community Yizkor service is held at 5:00 pm on Yom Kippur Day. The Yizkor memorial prayer is recited as part of the Torah reading ceremony. Please note that no set time is planned or announced for Shemini Atzeret, the eighth (8th) Day of Passover, and the second (2nd) Day of Shavuot. Contact the temple office for hours of services.

SISTERHOOD & MEN'S CLUB

Temple Sholom continues to offer its members social, educational and spiritual involvement. Sisterhood's role is to strengthen the bonds between members, by broadening their education and raising their awareness of the important topical issues that confront the modern Conservative Jewish woman. Sisterhood supports the Temple and its school both spiritually and financially. Exciting and interesting programs are offered throughout the year. The Men's Club has historically played an important role in the life of the Temple. It offers its members friendships, as well as cultural and social activities, but most importantly it allows for the opportunity of giving back something to the synagogue.

Our Temple Sholom Sisterhood operates our Gift Shop. The shop offers a wide variety of traditional and other Judaica and ritual items perfect for home, wedding, Bar/Bat Mitzvah and various holidays. All the proceeds from the gift shop benefit the educational programs of Temple Sholom.

OUTREACH

JEWS BY CHOICE is a group that welcomes all who are in the process of conversion or who have completed their conversion to Judaism. Discussions are warm and supportive, and include subjects of interest and concern suggested by group members. Spouses/Significant others are always welcome at Temple Sholom.

EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

HEBREW SCHOOL:

The Hebrew School has introduced its new and exciting curriculum to the Jewish community of South Florida. The Hebrew School has embarked on a year of learning and community service meeting every Sunday (except for holidays and scheduled vacations) from September through May and once a month for Shabbat/Saturday morning services.

Our Hebrew School incorporates the importance of Jewish education with the recognizing the needs of modern families. To this end, we provide:

- One day a week Hebrew School
- An individualized program that tailors the student's current knowledge with a plan for future success
- Small classes
- Motivated faculty who are dedicated to a single topic for all age groups
- Monthly Shabbat/Saturday morning service as part of our Temple Shabbat
- Experience
- Preparation for Bar and/or Bat Mitzvah
- A varied curriculum that includes Hebrew language, prayer, Jewish history, cultural education, music, and more!

BAR/BAT MITZVAH PREPARATION:

This program is conducted by the Cantor and includes individual instruction for each student. A prerequisite for Bar/Bat Mitzvah at the Jewish Center at Temple Sholom is 4 years in an approved Judaic studies program including enrollment for the entire year of the Bar/Bat Mitzvah.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **I want to become a member but can I afford it?**

This question is often the first one asked by potential members. No individual, couple or family is ever turned away because they cannot afford the dues! Our staff is available to discuss this sensitive issue with you.

- **I'm involved in Federation or other Jewish communal groups; why do I need to belong to a synagogue?**

The synagogue is the heart and soul of the Jewish Community. In communities with strong synagogue support, most other communal organizations are also strong. Without strong synagogues, the future of the Jewish community will be in doubt. There is a financial cost involved in membership, but the cost is a small price to pay to help Judaism survive.

- **I do not have children; why should I pay to belong?**

Dues cover a portion of the education expenses, but each family pays tuition to have their child/children in our Hebrew School. If the Jewish community is to

grow and survive, education is critical. If you are committed to the future of the Jewish community, it is important to understand that the future begins with today's children who will become tomorrow's parents and potential leaders. We appreciate that those without children help share in the mitzvah of providing education for the next generation of Jews.

- **Can I pay for High Holiday tickets instead of joining?**

Maybe up to now you've only attended synagogue a few days a year, but come and join us and you'll discover something very special – a FAMILY. Services and programs are stimulating and provide a family feeling for everyone throughout the year. In fact, we believe this is so true that High Holiday tickets are complimentary with your full-year membership.

- **I don't know any members.**

When you join Temple Sholom you become part of the family. Services are intimate and everyone is encouraged to get involved in auxiliaries, classes, and projects. By working together, we can get to know each other better.
